Professionals working in the field of aerospace and innovation are invited to join the event and to meet partners to develop new business ideas and network regarding future Clean Sky calls.

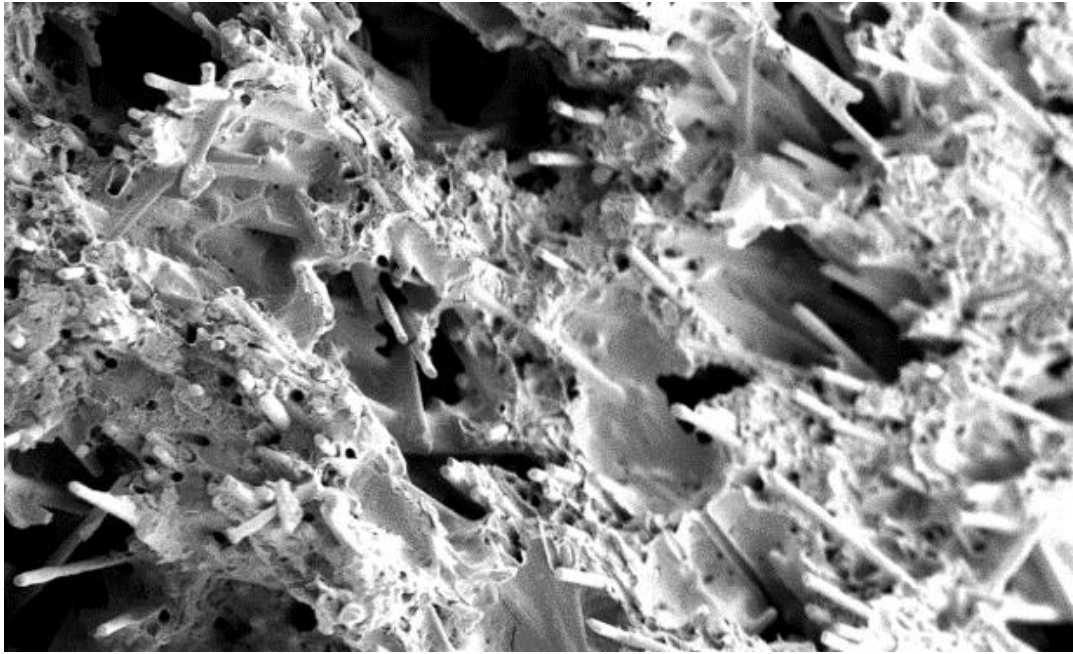

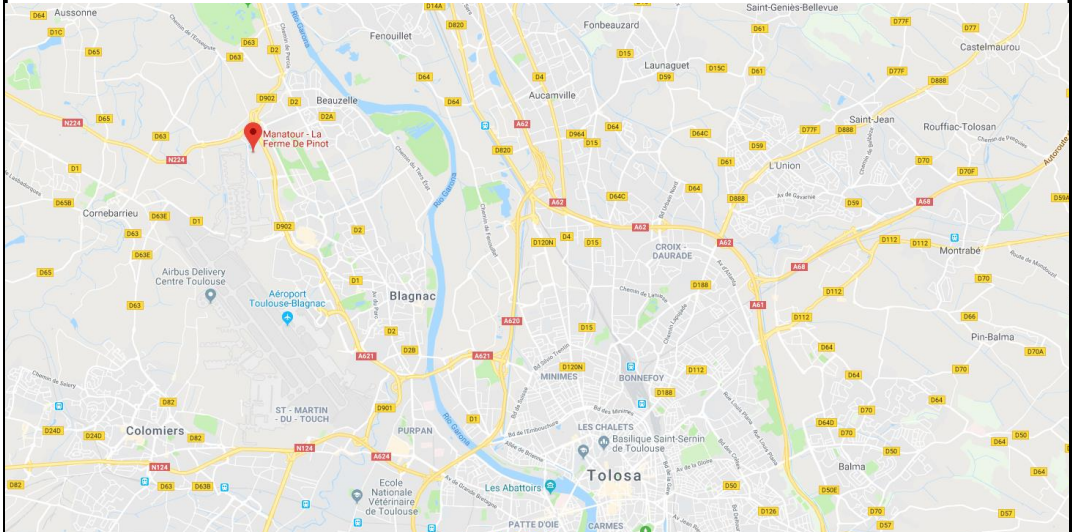
